"Mixed Media -- Acrylic and Collage" Deborah W. Pey



Debbie Pey is an award winning artist-teacher who has recently retired from 30 years of art education in the public schools of Burlington County. Beyond her degree, Debbie has studied textiles, puppetry, watercolors, jewelry, painting and collage. A natural outgrowth of her eclectic background is a love of mixed media.



Debbie's most recent work revolves around combining acrylic, watercolor crayons, oil pastels and assorted papers to create mixed media collages. Her first experimentation with this technique was an outgrowth of a workshop in Doylestown, PA which focused on still life. In the past few years, Debbie has adapted this process to florals, landscapes and cityscapes, finding that the combination of materials lends itself to creating rich and deep textures and vibrant energy.
