**Michael Budden, prize winning plein air artist will be demonstrating, in oil or acrylic,  
how he achieves his lovely outdoor paintings**



**Michael Budden** is an internationally known artist who lives and works in NJ. Budden concentrated on painting wildlife. Mike became dissatisfied with just the studio approach to painting and he started painting “**en plein air**”, painting outdoors direct from nature. His unique use of composition, mood and lighting had attracted the attention of

major art publishers, art magazines and museums. The artist states: “My transition to plein air painting is based on painting from my heart about what I see and how I feel about what I see not some notion about marketability. An artist learns more about value, color, and making decisions when painting direct from nature plus there is something freeing out there. I have returned to this pure reaction painting to the beautiful stimuli I encounter everyday

hopefully with a learned eye and honed skills.” Mike captures “a moment in time” in a particular location where the light grabs you and makes you stop and look. His paintings have captured the interest of many collectors.



Mike graduated with degrees in art from Mercer County Community College and the College Of New Jersey. He continues to enjoy

studying various periods of art history but especially likes **Impressionism**. He is an award winner and was invited to design the **White House Easter Egg** representing New Jersey where he met with the First Lady, Mrs. Laura Bush, during the unveiling of the exhibit. Take a look at **WAA artist Sharon Shaw's website** at [www.SharonShawArt.com](http://www.SharonShawArt.com). Sharon has a well designed web site, that includes an extensive gallery of excellent paintings, organized by subject matter.

Get up to speed regarding using a computer. The computer is a valuable resource for marketing your paintings, and for availing yourself of art related resources, from tutorials, to art communities & forums, to discount art supplies & art store coupons, to life model resource photos. Get computer help from your grandkids, or your local library, or other computer course offerings.

Do you have a Yahoo ID? It's free. Just sign up online at [www.Yahoo.com](http://www.Yahoo.com). Why you ask? Besides getting a free email account, you also have access to a variety of international art communities (called Yahoo Groups). Members of these communities ask questions, share techniques, display their artwork, and participate in group projects and contests.

Here are a few of the sixty-five Yahoo groups that I personally belong to:

- **“Digital Art From Scratch”** at [groups.yahoo.com/group/DigitalArtFromScratch](http://groups.yahoo.com/group/DigitalArtFromScratch) is for artists who create works of art using computer programs. Much digital art comes from manipulated images, whereas this site is for art that is created on a blank digital canvas with no external images used. (Moderators include WAA member David Diamond).
- **“Watercolors”** at [groups.yahoo.com/group/WATERCOLOR](http://groups.yahoo.com/group/WATERCOLOR) is, of course, a community of watercolorists. In addition to a discussion forum, and areas for individual artists to display their works, this group features a monthly theme project and contest. (Moderated by WAA member David Diamond and other artists).
- **“Figure Drawing Factory”** at [groups.yahoo.com/group/figure\\_drawing\\_factory](http://groups.yahoo.com/group/figure_drawing_factory) is a collaboration of artists and life models to facilitate figure drawing and figure painting in all media. You say your spouse does not want you to take a life model up to your studio? No problem. The volunteer life models at the Figure Drawing Factory will provide you with a variety of poses. Several types of monthly group assignments provide instruction, inspiration and challenges on various aspects and styles of figure drawing and painting.
