### “GREAT ART, GREAT STORIES” PRESENTED BY JEANA CAREY



Using slides, Jeana Carey will show us some of her favorite works from the Philadelphia Museum of Art's famed collections and recent special exhibitions. She selected each work for its unique story -- fascinating, little known information, sometimes about

how the piece came to be, its subject, its history, or perhaps how it came to the museum. You won't want to miss this peek behind the scenes!

Jeana Carey was a project manager who owned her own business. As a successful business person, she was afforded an opportunity to travel, and travel lead her to volunteering in Belize, Mexico with her daughter, Megan. This is where Jeana spent two years capturing the Mayan life and documenting her travels in her book entitled: “Mexico Sketches: an illustrated travel memoir”. Today, Jeana continues to learn about art and sharing with others as a Docent at the Philadelphia Art Museum.
