### *Sharon Paisner*

Demonstrating Techniques with Watercolor on Yupo.



Born and raised in Brooklyn, NY, Sharon received her degree in Education at Brooklyn College. After moving to Cherry Hill, NJ., she received an art degree at Glassboro State. and taught art and English for twenty-six years in Medford.

Upon retirement in 2003, Sharon pursued her lifelong interest in art on a full-time basis. It was then that she discovered her affinity for watercolor painting, enjoying the magical fluid properties of the medium and the endless possibilities for expression that it offered. She has studied with, and been inspired by the late, well-known local artist, Rosemary Hutchins. Development and growth has been further fulfilled with additional workshops given by artists including: Dolores Zeigler, Phillip Carroll, Ben Cohen, Dan Hines and Jane Lux.

"My goal is to always be excited about my work and to try to maintain a freshness in each new painting. The process should involve play, taking risks, and exploring creative possibilities. My aim is to achieve an overall painterly quality that allows the observer to continually reach beyond the obvious and find meaning with each viewing of the watercolor.

Taking advantage of the flowing quality of watercolor paint, I try to create a rich, impressionistic, almost fantasy painting that envelops and surprises. In addition to still-lives and landscapes, I enjoy abstracts for their subtlety, ambiguity, complexity and highly personal nature."

Sharon's recent exhibits of watercolor on Yupo are true masterpieces: and we look forward to seeing some of her techniques demonstrated along with some of her artwork.
