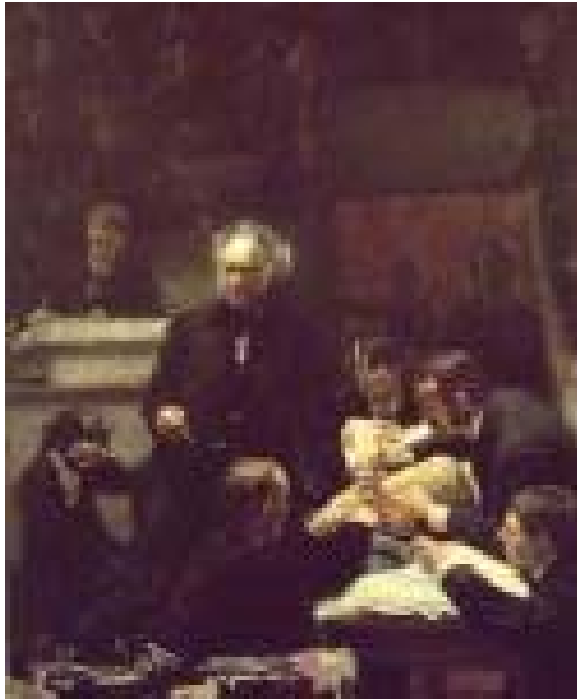

OUR MAY PROGRAM

Behrooz Salimnejad

Philadelphia Art Museum Conservator

Behrooz's early education at Khiabani Art Studios, Tabriz, Azerbaijan, followed by an apprenticeship in painting, sculpting, furniture making, carving of wood and stone, frame making, and restoration of furniture and other objects was enhanced by studies in fine arts at Nuremberg, West Germany, an MS in Art at Indiana State University, and finally studies in chemistry for use in conservation at Kutztown University, Kutztown, PA. Past exhibitions include solo exhibits at Art Works Gallery, Philadelphia Museum of Art in Phila., PA. and the Picasso Gallery, Washington, DC, where he is presently included in a group exhibit. Awards include first place followed by a show in Tehran International Fair, Tehran, Iran, and a Painting and Sculpting Award from the Lions Club in Tabriz, Tehran. He was commissioned to do a portrait of Prince Reza Pahlavi and Queen Farah Diba for the office of the Iranian Prime Minister, Abba Hoveida.



Beginning his career as restorer and framer for the Gentleman Framer and Art Gallery in Allentown, PA. he is presently a free-lance furniture conservator in Yardley, PA. In his present position as Conservator of Furniture and Woodwork at the Philadelphia Museum of Art, Phila, PA, he is responsible for care and treatment of furniture and architectural woodwork in the museum's collection. His extensive carving and gilding has restored six Philadelphia looking-glass frames and European furniture.

His presentation on repairing and restoring frames will introduce us to some of his special techniques.

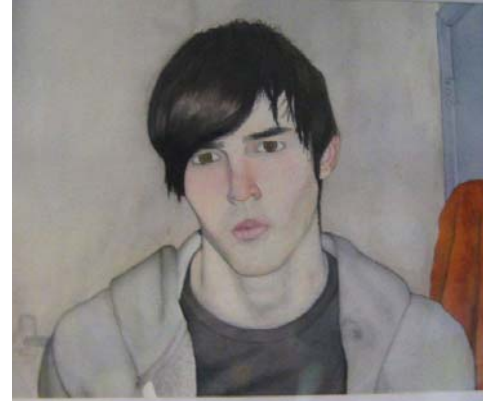
