OUR AUGUST PROGRAM

Wednesday, August 4th, 7 PM Susan Kauffman

Susan Carol Kauffman of Lumberton New Jersey taught in the Cherry Hill school system for 33 years. For fifteen years, she taught art. This artist earned an undergraduate degree in Art Education from Monmouth University and a Master's Degree in the same subject from Rowan University. She is currently an Adjunct Professor at The College of New Jersey where she is a Field Supervisor for Student Teachers.

After retiring in 2004, she joined a group of watercolor artists who paint together every Tuesday morning at the East Street Art Gallery in Columbus, New Jersey. There she was introduced to a medium that was new to her. Several years later with the help and support of these wonderful artists and friends she has developed a style with which she is comfortable. In recent months, Susan has been experimenting with acrylic painting and collage.

Susan is drawn to the beauty of nature particularly found here in Burlington County. Buildings with character, forests, fields, and flower gardens are favored subjects. She is sensitive to small details and the play of light on surfaces.

It takes a long period of time to complete a painting, but Susan enjoys the process of creating. As one element of the painting is completed, this artist is excited to go on to the next texture. Susan is also a gardener and Vice President of the Mount Holly Garden Club, so she has a great variety of source material from which to draw inspiration in her extensive perennial garden.

Another technique that Susan employs is called "glue printing" which is a type of relief printing often called a collograph. She first came upon this technique when teaching Middle School students. Since retiring and having more time for experimentation, Susan decided to revisit this technique. The artist completes a drawing on cardboard or other rigid surface. White glue is then applied to all the lines in the design with a pencil point or toothpick or with the glue bottle itself. When the glue is dried, the cardboard is then inked and printed on Japanese rice paper. The print is then hand painted with colored inks.

This artist also enjoys creating artistic scrapbooks. She has presented demonstrations and conducted workshops at scrapbooking weekend retreats in Pennsylvania and New Jersey.
